Entry requirements

All applicants must have:

- Teaching assistant experience
- Some experience of leading whole class learning with no teacher present
- Level 2 or equivalent in Maths and English (documentary evidence will be required).

If you do not hold a level 2 in English and/or Maths we advise that you contact your local FE college who provide these qualifications free of charge. Alternatively you can contact an online provider. These providers may allow you to complete the qualification in a shorter timeframe, however there is a course fee to pay. This is all done directly through your chosen provider.
